

Hot Tub Troubleshooting Tip

Control Panel Malfunction

Step 1: Reset the System

- ❑ **Turn off the power to the hot tub for a few minutes:** Switch off the main power to the hot tub at the circuit breaker.
- ❑ **Turn the power back on and check the control panel:** After waiting a few minutes, turn the power back on and see if the control panel resets and functions normally.

Step 2: Check the Connections

- ❑ **Ensure all control panel connections are secure:** Open the control panel and inspect all electrical connections for tightness and corrosion.
- ❑ **Look for any signs of corrosion or damage:** Clean any corroded connections with a contact cleaner and a soft brush. Replace any damaged wires or connectors.

Step 3: Update the Firmware

- ❑ **Refer to the hot tub manual for instructions on updating the firmware.** Updating the system firmware can resolve some control panel issues. Follow the manual's instructions for downloading and installing the latest updates.
