	□ Step 3 : Gently scrub the shell in circular motions, paying extra attention to buildup or stains. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive tools—they can damage the acrylic.
	Note: For stubborn spots, use a vinegar solution (1 part vinegar, 3 parts
	water). Apply and let it sit for a few minutes before wiping clean.
3.	Rinse Thoroughly
	□ After cleaning, rinse the shell thoroughly with clean water. Make sure no cleaner residue
	remains, as it can affect the water chemistry when you refill the tub.
4.	Dry the Shell
	□Use a dry microfiber cloth to wipe down the shell. This prevents water spots and streaks,
	leaving your hot tub looking pristine.

5. Refill the Hot Tub

□ Once the shell is clean and dry, refill your hot tub with water, ensuring it's at the correct level. Test the water balance with a hot tub test strip and adjust as needed.
